Class a. Baby Puppy Dog 4-6 months 4(2)

- Van-Beck's Another Bug with Newlaithe. R/W 5mths presenting a compact, square
 outline. Front was good with well-laid shoulders balanced to a nicely angulated rear.
 Slightly sloping topline and correct tail set. Nice tight feet for a baby. Head was strong
 with super dark eyes, padded muzzle with a wide, straight mouth and correctly set ears.
 Mischievous expression. Lovely to see a super confident baby who moved out well, and
 pleased to award him Best Special Baby Puppy in Event.
- 2. **Eaves' Kajobox Kick Start.** Dark B/W 4mths with a sharp outline. A more elegant dog who is a tad longer at this stage. Good front, standing well over parallel legs. Cleaner head, which was well padded, another super wide mouth. Kind expression. Moved out steadily.

Class b. Baby Puppy Bitch 4-6 months 2(1)

1. **Eaves' Kajobox Jump Start.** Dark B/W 4 mths, presenting a square outline. Balanced angles front to rear, short-coupled. Slightly sloping topline. Good reach of neck. Stands well over parallel legs, nicely filled in front. Pleasing. clean head with a blocky muzzle, balanced to skull. Moved well for such a baby.

Class c. Puppy Dog 6-8 months 2(0)

- 1. Renshaw Turner & Turner's Newlaithe Northern Soul at Sonshoby. Square B/W 7mths, with a crisp elegant outline, still raw as expected, but everything in the right place. Good front, clean over the shoulders and well-angulated rear. Flows nicely from his crested neck into withers, correct slope to topline and good tail set. Pleasing, expressive head, full of attitude and mischief, with well-padded muzzle and big nostrils. Nice wide mouth. Just needs time to body up. Moved well.
- 2. **Carter's Susancar Finn Ominal.** B/W 7 mths, with more substance than 1 but still retaining elegance. Presented a pleasing, balanced outline and bang on tail set. Super cat feet. Clean, well laid shoulders, Balanced head with a kind expression, and well padded muzzle. Another good mover, just preferred the head on 1 at this stage.

Class d. Puppy Dog 8-10 Months 2(0)

- 1. **Kavanagh's Marbleton Mix'n Match.** Striking R/W dog 8mths, compact square outline with super front and moderately angulated rear. Nice short back, correct tail set. Stood well over front legs. Powerful male felt lovely to go over. Super head, with dark, well-padded muzzle, correctly shaped dark eyes, evident chin and well set ears, excellent mouth, big nostrils. Will watch his progress with interest. Best Special Puppy Dog.
- 2. **Wilkes' Marbleton Ebb'n Flo.** R/W dog 8mths. Rangier than 1, and appears a tad longer at this stage. Good front, balanced to well-angulated rear, lovely reach of neck, nicely arched. Clean head of correct proportions, nice dark eye.

Class e. Puppy Dog 10-12 months 0

Class f. Puppy Bitch 6-8 Months 2(0)

- 1. Welch's Newlaithe Bridget Jones with Treju. Super dark B/W 7mths. Classy outline, standing well over front, well-angulated rear, nice short back. Correct topline and tail set. Clean over the shoulders, nice parallel legs, short-coupled. Prettiest of heads, with correct proportions, well-padded blocky muzzle, clean through the skull, mouth is good. Lovely expression. Moved very well. Best Special Puppy Bitch. Pulled out all the stops in the challenge to take Best Special Puppy in Event.
- 2. **Van-Beck's Newlaithe Come on Y'all.** Another lovely dark B/W bitch 7 mths. Presents a compact balanced outline, good front, well angulated rear, nice short back and correct topline. Not as well filled as 1 at this stage. Pleasing, clean head, well-padded muzzle and clean skull, good mouth, Moved well.

Class i. Junior Dog 12-15 months 2(1)

1. Chell's Jimbren Elite Legacy at Ludic. Quality B/W 14mths with super outline, shown in excellent condition, felt lovely to go over. Found him to be exactly as he should be for his age. Super reach of neck, short back and loins, stood well over his well-filled front. Smooth lines with no exaggeration. Front well balanced to rear with bang on tail set. Super cat feet. Head is lovely, expressive, with dark eyes, blocky, well proportioned, clean skull, correct wrinkle, with good mouth. Moved well exhibiting drive. Pleased to award him Best Junior Dog, Best Junior in Event and Best Special Event Winner overall.

Class j. Junior Dog 15-18 months 1(0)

1. **Murfin & Hart's Farvalley Pure Delight.** Red B/W 15mths. Moderately angled but balanced front to rear. Super reach of neck, correct topline, and short back. Pleasing head with kind expression, well-padded muzzle, clean through the skill and good mouth. Nice unexaggerated male, just needs to drop in brisket. Moved nicely and well-handled.

Class k. Junior Bitch 12-15 2(0)

- McCarthy & Gething's Boxania Don't Blame Me at Jeddhi. Compact, square Red B/W
 13mths. Well laid shoulders, stands well over front legs, balanced to hammy rear.
 Correct topline and bang on tail set. Clean throughout. Pleasing head, with well padded
 muzzle and kind eye, correct ear set and good mouth. Lively expression, Moved out well.
 Presented in hard condition. Showed her socks off in the challenge to win Best Special
 Junior Bitch.
- 2. **Flintoft's Boxania Ebony Eyes.** Dark B/W 13mths presenting a more elegant outline. Super front which is balanced to rear, nice reach of neck, well filled in front. Pretty head, lovely dark muzzle, super mouth. Moved well and sympathetically handled.

Class I. Junior Bitch 15-18 months 4(1)

1. **Woods' Arkeney Geneva.** B/W 16mths presenting a balanced outline, moderately angled front and rear. Super reach of neck, well-filled in front, nice tight feet. Correct slope to topline. Lovely, clean head with excellent eye shape and correctly padded muzzle in proportion to skull. Excellent mouth. Powerful girl, one of the best movers here, won on her effortless ground covering stride.

- 2. **Littlewood's Airwaves Over Newlaithe.** Dark B/W 17mths similar in many properties to 1. Square outline, nicely balanced, well-angulated rear. Super bone and tight cat feet. Correct topline and tail set. Another pleasing head, with well-padded muzzle, good mouth. Still needs to fill in front. Moved well.
- 3. Wood's Normybox Your Ready Now at Xarazar
