#### **Baby Puppy Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Brooks & Tooby's Jimi Hendrix at Jinnybrux

This happy puppy fitted his gleaming red jacket extremely well. Stood foursquare on tight feet with very good angulations. Good bone. Lovely clean head and super pigmentation. Moved gaily with confidence. Well-schooled and sympathetically handled. BBP

2<sup>nd</sup> Turner's Newlaithe Northern Soul at Sonshoby

Taller, rangier b/w puppy giving his Mum a hard time! Clean head and neck, and good angulations.

#### **Baby puppy Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> Van Beck's Newlaithe Come On Y'all

Promising dark b/w baby of almost 6 months standing foursquare for her handler. Good outline, pretty head and good mouth. Feet could be tighter.

2<sup>nd</sup> Welch's Newlaithe Bridget Jones with Treju

Another pretty headed b/w baby of almost 6 months for whom the same comments apply. Not as well-schooled as 1.

#### **Veteran Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Kelly's Casemates Gandalf

Impressive b/w male of 9 years with plenty of ring presence. Good substance. Well-proportioned head type, arched neck which sloped nicely into his strong broad back, good shoulder angulation with evident forechest, good quarters and tight feet on which he powered around the ring. BVD & BVIS

#### **Minor Puppy Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Kavanagh's Marbleton Mix'n Match

Well-grown red/white puppy of just 6 months shown in lovely condition. Lovely well-proportioned head with clean skull and good pigmentation. Super front assembly and quarters. Everything just right for his age. Moved with confidence on super tight feet.

2<sup>nd</sup> Kelly's Casemates Hagrid

Attractive chestnut b/w puppy of 8 months not as mature as 1 and still to grow into his body. Clean typey head of good proportions but he fidgeted so construction was difficult to assess.

#### **Puppy Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Huggins' Boxania Rock and Roll Star for Daervlish

Stylish 11 months dark b/w with super substance and eye-catching square outline. Clean nicely proportioned head in the making with dark eyes, lively expression and good mouth. Well-schooled to show off his lovely construction. Super clean arch to his neck flowing body lines and good angulations. Good depth of brisket, turn of stifle and well let down hocks into the tightest of feet. Moved confidently and freely around the ring. A most promising puppy. BPD

### **Junior Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Carter's Farvalley Major Luke at Susancar

Exciting chestnut b/w stallion of a male whose superb ring presence demands attention. On his toes the whole time. Tall and elegant combined with substance. Beautiful headpiece with excellent muzzle to clean skull proportions, wide straight mouth, distinct stop, good rise of skull and dark eyes looking for mischief! Long clean arched neck flowing smoothly into his short strong back with its bang on tail set. Super shoulder angulation with excellent foreleg height showing off his lovely forechest. Flowing underline to neat tuck-up, very good quarters and the tightest of feet, which drove him around the ring on a mission. I wouldn't change a thing about him. Loved him! DCC & BIS

2<sup>nd</sup> Huckerby & Dowell's Norwilbeck Bellchime Belta

Smart dark b/w male with a most attractive head and expression and very good show temperament. Good outline with good angulations front and rear, flat back and good quarters. Would prefer more height of foreleg to complete the picture. Moved and handled extremely well.

### **Yearling Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Mair's Ch Sulez Striker at Glenauld JW

Eyecatching dark b/w stallion male with fabulous substance. Totally square and balanced in outline. Medium size with textbook angulations front and rear, super forechest, parallel front, short broad flat back and excellent tail set. Neat underline and tuck-up to strongly muscled quarters, super turn of stifle and well let down hocks to super tight feet. Strong masculine head with lovely dark eyes and expression. Expertly handled, he powered around the ring.

### **Novice Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Chell's Jimbren Elite Legacy at Ludic

Quality upstanding b/w male only just out of puppy with good breed type. Good balance of substance with elegance. Most appealing clean head in the making with dark well-shaped eyes and lovely expression. Long clean neck, good shoulder layback and true front. Excellent tight feet. Sympathetically handled and went well on the move. Can only improve with maturity.

2<sup>nd</sup> Payne's Jeddhi Through the Flame at Birleyvale

Compact dark b/w with good bone, flat back, good quarters, and tightly arched feet. Would prefer cleaner neck and skull.

### **Graduate Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Law & Pynegar's Shellark Spence is Dynamite with Berwynfa

Cobby b/w male with good size and substance. His head is rather overdone for me and I would prefer a larger eye. Good front angulation and good feet. Rear quarters and angulation were hard to ascertain as handler had his back legs overstretched.

### **Limit Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> Woods' Arkeney Conqueror

Tall and elegant b/w male that I liked a lot. Good substance but not overdone in any way. Harmonious profile with long clean neck, good angulations front and rear and good tight feet. Such a lovely clean head of correct proportions with distinct stop and good rise. Good mouth with good lip placement, shapely dark eyes with lovely expression. Moved extremely well, at one with his handler.

2<sup>nd</sup> Van Beck's Newlaithe Respect JW

Impressive b/w male beautifully schooled to show freestanding. Super show temperament. Typical well-balanced head, long clean neck, good round bone and excellent front assembly, short back and super confident tail set. Strong quarters which drove him effortlessly around the ring.

### **Open Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> McCarthy & Gething's Ch Boxania Romanoff to Jeddhi

Beautifully constructed b/w male. Totally balanced square outline teeming with breed type. His head is outstanding, beautifully balanced, nicely padded muzzle to clean skull, good mouth, chin and lip placement, good stop and rise of skull and fabulous black pigmentation. Correctly shaped dark expressive eyes giving a lovely soft expression. Correctly angulated front and rear, short flat back, excellent muscled quarters with good turn of stifle and tight feet. Excellent movement. Res CC & RBIS

2<sup>nd</sup> Kavanagh's Marbleton in the Mix

Upstanding b/w male with a lovely head of excellent proportions, good rise to clean skull, super wide mouth with correct dentition and correct lip to lip placement, well-shaped dark eyes giving that unique Boxery expression. Slightly longer cast than 1 he has an elegant outline, parallel front, good angulations and tight feet, moving with purpose around the ring.

### **Veteran Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> Murfin's Farvalley Instant Love

This 11 years old b/w lady stole my heart! Square, compact with a clean head, beautiful dark eyes and glorious grey chops. She moved around the ring like a seven-year-old thoroughly enjoying her day. What fantastic genes she must have! Sympathetically handled and presented in very good condition. BVB.

### **Minor Puppy Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> Pynegar's Dolly Wally Doodle

Beautiful 9 months b/w puppy, compact square outline, with excellent angulations, parallel front and tight cat feet. Clean feminine head, expressive dark eyes, excellent mouth with good lip placement. Super show temperament, she moved really well. Expertly handled and in gleaming condition. One for the future. BPIS

2<sup>nd</sup> Mair's Glenauld Storm Felicity

Smart dark b/w bitch of 9 months very similar to 1 although slightly taller. Clean square outline, good bone and tight feet. Good front and well angulated front and rear. Good head and dark eyes but preferred the mouth of 1. Shown in lovely condition, she moved and showed well.

### **Puppy Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> McCarthy & Gething's Boxania Don't Blame Me at Jeddhi

Quality b/w bitch of 11 months with so much to like. Unexaggerated well-balanced square construction, good front with good shoulder layback, clean neck, short-coupled, good quarters with good tail set. Clean and well-proportioned pretty feminine head with lovely expression from her dark eyes. Happy puppy!

2<sup>nd</sup> Flintoff's Boxania Ebony Eyes

Dark b/w bitch without the white markings of 1 to glamourise her outline. Good substance, clean neck, short back and good front. Preferred the quarters and angulations of 1. Most appealing clean head nicely balanced muzzle to skull and liquid ebony eyes.

### **Junior Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> Pearce & Francis' Ch Longsdale Crazy for You

Stunning dark b/w bitch who just completely filled my eye. Medium size, superb square outline with sweeping underline standing foursquare on tightly arched feet. Good bone, parallel front, clean arched neck running smoothly into short flat back. Excellent quarters and well let down hocks drove her around the ring in style. Beautiful feminine head, clean with super muzzle to skull proportions,

excellent wide mouth, and gorgeous expression. Presented in immaculate condition. Considered for the BCC and strongly contested the Res BCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> McCarthy & Gething's Lorrosa My Heads Been Turned to Jeddhi

Another top-class dark b/w bitch slightly taller than winner with good substance and correct outline. Most attractive clean head and soft expression. Nicely arched neck, short flat back, short-coupled with correctly angulated quarters and good feet. Moved well and presented in super condition. A very nice bitch.

### **Yearling Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> Drinkwater's Ch Sulez Smashedit

This lovely b/w bitch oozes breed type. Her outline is textbook substance with elegance, and she has lovely flowing body lines with correct angulations, good feet and a neat tuck-up. She has a beautifully balanced clean head with lovely eyes, good mouth and chin. Good reach of neck into a strong, short flat back, great spring of rib and correct tail set. Excellent quarters with good width of second thigh. Presented in immaculate and hard condition, she moved very well. Considered for the BCC.

### **Novice Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> McDonald's Yeteb Little Miss Splendid

There is so much to like about this attractive dark b/w young lady, just out of puppy. She has a neat square outline, very pretty well-shaped head and eye. Parallel front, flowing body lines, good tail set and tightly arched feet. She has good quarters and really super movement which sealed this class for her.

2<sup>nd</sup> Mair's Merribox in Cahoots with Glenauld

This quality b/w bitch was close up to the winner, and many of the same comments apply. Super substance, correct angulations, tight cat feet, good tailset. Just preferred the movement of 1.

### **Graduate Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> Pearce & Francis' Longsdale Here Ya Come Again

Classy dark b/w with beautifully balanced outline. Elegant arched neck, super forechest and rear angulations, good tuck-up, turn of stifle and super feet. The prettiest of heads nicely proportioned and the sweetest expression from her lovely dark eyes. Shown in excellent condition and expertly handled.

2<sup>nd</sup> Chell's Joru Time for Change for Ludic

Attractive dark b/w bitch with short back, good front and rear angulations and good feet. Would prefer cleaner neck. My notes make specific mention of the excellent easy reach and drive she exhibited on the go around.

### **Postgraduate Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> Huggins' Willow Belle Star for Daervlish

Smart dark b/w bitch with well-proportioned feminine head with lovely expression, nicely arched neck, good parallel front and good shoulder angulation. Strong quarters, well angulated and good feet. Full of herself today and giving her handler a tough time, but she moved around the ring well and did enough to take this class.

2<sup>nd</sup> Payne's Birleyvale Burning Heart

This very nice dark b/w bitch was close up to winner, but she didn't want to play today. Taller and rangier than 1 she has a lovely outline, clean feminine head and neck, parallel front, flat back, and strong quarters.

## **Limit Bitch**

### **1<sup>st</sup> Drinkwater's Sulez Teaser**

Tall & elegant but feminine b/w girl with fabulous substance, and excellent breed type. Truly beautiful head, which seen in profile, is in perfect proportion muzzle to skull. Distinct stop, clean skull with beautifully shaped dark eyes giving kind expression. Good mouth and lip placement and a lovely tilt to her nose. The best of fronts with correct shoulder angulation, clean arched neck into broad flat back with excellent spring of rib and the kind of strong hammy quarters that I love, that moved her effortlessly around the ring. ### **2<sup>nd</sup> Pynegar's Skies the Limit with Berwynfa**

Top drawer young bitch in a gleaming dark b/w jacket presenting an elegant square outline. Super round bone, true front and good shoulder angulation. Beautiful head with well-padded muzzle and excellent straight dentition. Melting expression from her gorgeous well-shaped dark eyes. Another excellent moving bitch, who must be destined for great things.

## **Open Bitch**

### **1<sup>st</sup> Carter's Ch Susancar Celia Deal**

I have admired this beautiful stylish b/w bitch from afar since she was a puppy and was delighted to finally have the opportunity to judge her today. Perfectly square symmetrical outline, smooth flowing underline and neat tuck-up. Super combination of substance and elegance, and wonderful breed type. Such a feminine head beautifully balanced muzzle to clean skull, distinct stop, good mouth, lovely well-shaped dark eyes with that special soft Boxery expression. Lovely arch to her neck leading smoothly over her withers into her slightly sloping topline to a bang on tail set. Unexaggerated angulations fore and aft and tight cat feet complete the picture. She moved smartly with an easy and effortless stride around the ring, and I was pleased to award her the BCC.

### **2<sup>nd</sup> Hare's Ch Jimbren Queen of Tarts**

Another lovely b/w bitch, albeit a different type to 1, and in a slightly larger frame. Beautiful feminine head with excellent muzzle to skull proportions and lovely well-shaped dark eyes. Lovely flowing body lines, and another superb moving bitch. Showed and handled well.
